PENALTIES, LOADINGS AND ALLOWANCES																	
(1) District Allowance (no longer payable)																	
(2) Broken Periods of Work Allowance for Full-Time and Part-Time Staff Only (clause 21.3(a)): Time between periods of work is 2 hours and up to 3 hours - \$2.76 per day. Time between periods of work is more than 3 hours - \$4.19 per day.																	
(3) Meal Allowance (clause 21.1(a)): \$12.97 per meal.																	
(4) Tool Allowance (clause 21.1(b)): \$1.55 per day or part thereof up to a maximum of \$7.60 per week																	
(5) Board and lodging: Refer to clause 39.3 of the Award for Junior deductions.																	
(6) Fork lift driver allowance (clause 21.2(a)): Full-time employee - \$12.56 per week. Part-time and casual employees - \$2.51 per day, up to a maximum of \$12.56 per week.																	
(7) First aid allowance (clause 21.2(b)): Full-time employee - \$10.05 per week. Part-time and casual employees - \$2.01 per day, up to a maximum of \$10.05 per week.																	
(8) Late/Early Work Penalties - All employees are entitled to late/early work penalties between the hours 7pm to 7am Monday to Friday at the following rates (clause 32.3): Between 7pm & midnight: Payment is \$2.20 per hour or any part of an hour. Between midnight & 7am: Payment is \$3.31 per hour or any part of an hour.
